

Founded in 1915 as the Cartographic Group, the first division of National Geographic, National Geographic Maps has been responsible for illustrating the world around us through the art and science of mapmaking. Today, National Geographic Maps continues this mission by creating the world's best wall maps, recreation maps, atlases, and globes which inspire people to care about and

explore their world.

This National Geographic Montreal Destination Map (like the other Destination Maps) is designed to be easy-to-use and uncluttered, rather than fitting in a maximum level of detail. Only the central area around downtown is covered in reasonably high detail - and even then it's still less detail than most ordinary \$5 paper maps you can buy anywhere. The city in its entirety and the nearby surrounding cities is covered in a small, separate Montréal area map section, but in very low detail. If you need to drive or navigate around the city (and want a real map, not GPS), this map won't suffice; a full-size folding paper map will work much better..But this map is decent as a tourist map - that's what it was designed for. It's colorful and gives useful descriptions and information about the must-see tourist locations. It has a closeup section of Vieux (Old) Montréal, as well as small mini maps of transit, the Montréal Souterrain (Underground), Olympic Park, Trudeau (Dorval) International Airport, and the Northeast USA/Québec region. It unfolds to a medium size (not too big), and is made of thick plastic 'paper' that is completely waterproof. However after several years, my map is starting to tear a little bit at the folds in two places.

I used this product on a recent trip to Montreal. Since I'm not 800 years old, I don't care much for the touristy portions of the city, so the little inset for Vieux Montreal was only relevant on one day. The map is standard fare, easy to understand and covers the bulk of the central areas of the city, up to Outremont. Streets, parks, government buildings, The Metro and the like are shown. The map itself is based on a matte, plastic-coated media, so it doesn't absorb moisture and when you fold it the "wrong" way, it doesn't tear or complain. The size, both folded and unfolded were completely manageable and not too big, not too small.And yes, paper maps are still relevant if you can't afford to pay for smart phone data roaming outside your home country.

We used this street map every day while touring and also to plan our trip. It was the best map of the city!

Very small print. Had a hard time reading this map even with reading glasses.

This may be useful for a tourist but for a new resident, it doesn't include enough of the outskirts of the city, and the zoomed in view of downtown is right on top of part of my daily bike commute, so it's not really useful for me.

This was a waste. I purchased Fodor's travel guide and this was already in it. It's just a map that you wouldn't want to be caught looking at in public. Your computer and phone are better.

A must have if you are visiting the city.

But we didn't use it as much as the map(s) we were given at our hotel and at tourist centers. If you need a map before you embark on your journey, it's as good as any.
