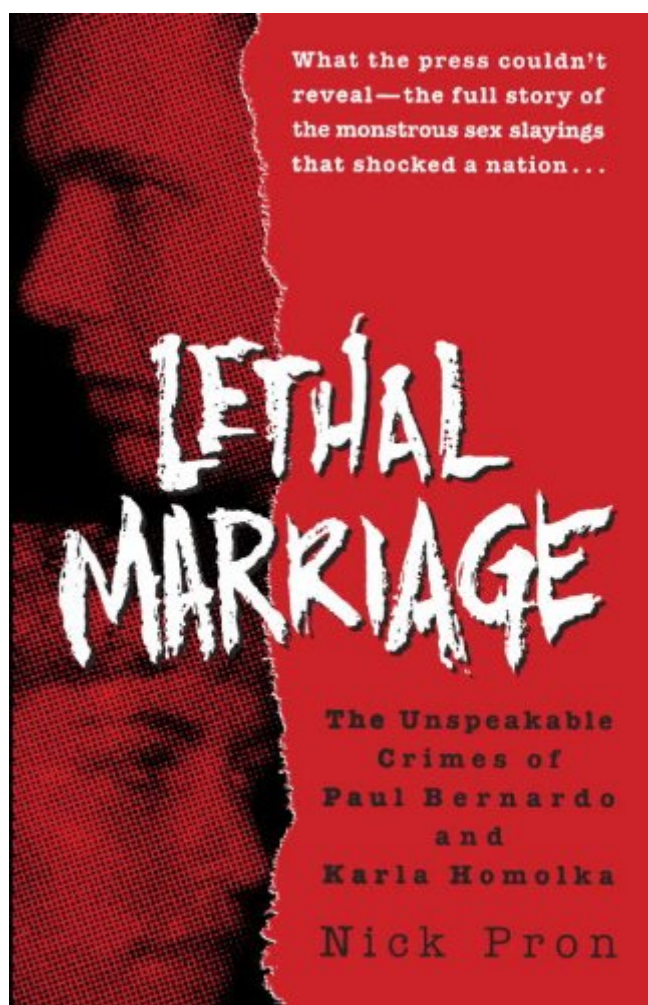

Descriptions of the terrible sexual abuse suffered by the victims in this case are not for the faint of

heart. Any agency wanting to release or parole this animal would be well served to read this book. Karla on the other hand is out and free. One must make their own minds up as to the extent of her involvement. After reading the book I think she should, at the very least, be sitting in the cell next to Bernardo so they can relive and again enjoy every moment of the sadistic depravity they unleashed on their innocent victims. They should grow old together in a penitentiary far away from decent people who can only be sickened by these two primordial stains on decent societies toilet.

If you are looking for information about these crimes/case, I would highly recommend! Be prepared to read quite a lot of "uncomfortable" details that you have likely never heard before, many of which are difficult to process (how another human being can be so cold, callous, depraved). I learned quite a few alarming new facts about the case in this book, despite having read a number of other books, lots of information online & watching more than a few documentaries about this case. Well done!

Yes, the story is gruesome. Yes, the story tells the horror that was experienced by the victims. Yes, it's a story of real life's darkest secrets. It also is a story that's well written and obviously well researched. The reader is warned as to the descriptive content. Also. The reader can simply leave the story at any time. I don't think the author could have a the story in any other way. To do so would have lessened the reality of the situation. The horror of the killings is what showed the motive of the killers and the sick personalities they possessed. Also, not to have told the story as it was done, may have left count as to the guilt that was so blatantly obvious after reading all the details. At least to some degree justice was served.

A little too graphic at times, but I can understand by putting in some of the sickening and horrific details, the reader can fully comprehend the level of depravity of these killers. My feelings from this book are, that while justice may have been served in this case, it should've been a far deeper justice than these two individuals received.

The book is a very well written work about the Canadian schoolgirl murders by Bernardo and Homolka. It covers every detail concerning the case, and describes the crimes and sadistic mindsets of Bernardo and Homolka. I would recommend this book to people interested in criminology. My only complaint is that the book is very, very disturbing and extremely graphic. If you are sensitive to detailed descriptions of murder, torture, and child rape, then this book is not for you.
