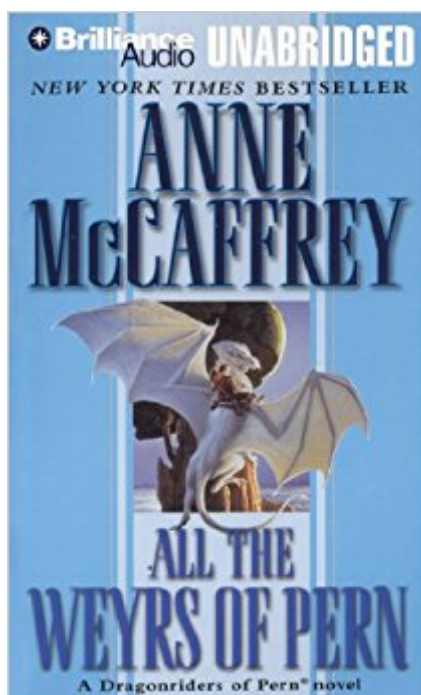

With its help, F'lar, Robinton, Lessa, Menolly, and all of the other characters YAs have come to care

about devise a risky plan to eliminate a serious threat to their environment. The Dragonriders of Pern are some of my very favorite stories. Anne McCaffrey (not Todd) has built such a wonderful world that when you finish the series you feel like so many of these people are your friends, and you just know Pern really exists out there, just waiting for us to re-discover it. I love "All the Weyrs of Pern" because it ties the current population to their "ancestors" after they discover AIVIS, a voice activated computer system that holds a lot of their history, and a possible way out of the dilemma that they have faced all their lives. I would recommend starting with the first three books first, so that you have a foundation for the story. Once you start, it is hard to put any of them down.

Recently bought a copy of the original trilogy at a library sale and enjoyed as much as I did years and years ago.This book brings back the original characters from the first series. It includes Jaxon and Ruth. It is not a stand alone novel. While I enjoyed the reunited characters, it focuses on the technical aspects of exploring and learning from the find of the original ship that brought men to Pern. It was Ok, seemed to lack some of the more emotional awe inspiring moments of the original trilogy.

I admit that this is a re read for me having force fed myself all the Pern series through this offering in the 1990s. Nobody can read this as a stand alone novel and fully appreciate the work, it is decades

of world building and backstory. I understood the blending of the characters and the reveal of the Avis entity to allow some sort of resolution to the epic series. The franchise has no doubt been passed on to family members with a keyboard and a passion for dragons. I enjoyed this culminating tale by Anne McCaffrey, while ending bitter sweet.
