

The Brothers Grimm, Jacob (1785–1863) and Wilhelm Grimm (1786–1859), were German academics, linguists, cultural researchers, lexicographers and authors who together collected and published folklore. They are among the most well-known storytellers of folk tales, popularizing stories such as "Cinderella", "The Frog Prince", "Hansel and Gretel", "Rapunzel", "Rumpelstiltskin", and "Snow White". Their first collection of folk tales, *Children's and Household Tales* (Kinder- und Hausmärchen), was published in 1812. The brothers spent their formative years first in the German town of Hanau. Their father's death in 1796, (when Jacob was eleven and Wilhelm ten), caused great poverty for the family and affected the brothers for many years. They both attended the University of Marburg and at the same time developed a curiosity for folklore, which grew into a lifelong dedication to collecting German folk tales. The rise of romanticism in the 19th century revived interest in traditional folk stories and represented a pure form of national literature and culture to the brothers. With the goal of researching a scholarly treatise on folk tales, the brothers established a methodology for collecting and recording folk stories that became the basis for folklore studies. Between 1812 and 1857 their first collection was revised and published many times and grew from 86 stories to more than 200. In addition to writing and modifying folk tales, the brothers wrote collections of well-respected German and Scandinavian mythologies and in

1838 began writing a definitive German dictionary, that remained incomplete in their lifetime. The popularity of the Grimms' collected folk tales endured well beyond their lifetimes. The tales are available in more than 100 translations and have been adapted by filmmakers including Lotte Reiniger and Walt Disney, with films such as Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs and Sleeping Beauty. In the mid-20th century the tales were used as propaganda by the Third Reich; later in the 20th century psychologists such as Bruno Bettelheim reaffirmed the value of the work, in spite of the cruelty and violence in the original versions of some of the tales that were sanitized.

A beautiful book especially for the price. I love that the intro includes some information on the brothers and short stories. There are 201 stories and 10 legends included in this book. I purchased this book because I wanted to see the fairytales in their more original versions. Plus this looked so amazing and well put together and was only \$15 at the time so I couldn't pass it up. It took about 2 weeks to get here. Part of that was due to me choosing the free saver shipping but I think FedEx dropped the ball as well. It took a few days to ship and when it finally got to the FedEx distributor near me it sat there for 4 days, 3 days past when it said it would be delivered. Other than that this book is excellent. It has a hard leather (or pleather) cover with intricate details and artwork and the page edges have that gold stuff on them. It has all the look of a book from 200 years ago with none of the wear. All in all the book is a great way to get some insight into the peasantry of Germany 200 years ago. Some of the stories are extremely similar, with different names and other small differences but ultimately the same. I believe this is due to a story being told in one area and getting told differently down the road. I can highly recommend this book however.

Again, I'm going to state that asking one to describe plot and characters to a book one just received and has not yet read in order to write a review is utterly ridiculous. However, I ordered this as a gift and it is ABSOLUTELY BEAUTIFUL. The book is leather bound and in excellent condition with gold rimmed pages and cloth book bookmark. I am so elated with this book I may have to order another for myself. The type is smaller than one would hope, but for a collector of classic literature it is a beautiful edition to add to one's collection!! Also, my order arrived several days early which has almost never happened!!

Wow is this a nice looking book! The picture here just simply does no justice. It has that old feel to it. Just like these stories deserve. The barcode was a little sticker that peels off with ease on the back. So it keeps this book looking great. I always hate when these manufactures make a nice looking book and then ruin it with a big ugly barcode on the back. Thankfully this book does not fall into that fate! If you love the old Grimm stories then buy this book! You won't regret it!

For the \$18 I was paying for this book, I was not expecting it to be as absolutely gorgeous as it was. The binding is clean, the designs are really well done and everything about this leather binding just screams quality. I got it as a gift for my girlfriend, who is a librarian, and even she said that the quality is great. That being said this is the first leather bound bin that I have purchased online, rather than in person, and I would highly recommend this edition. It really is a gorgeous book, and even if you aren't into the Grimm Brothers and want a fancy book to adorn your bookshelf or anything else, this is the one to do it.

This book is gorgeous!!!! I couldn't believe the quality of the book for the price, it was EXACTLY what I was looking for. My oldest child became very interested when I was telling him about the Non-Disney versions of the original fairy tales. This book has become a nightly read for us together, one story a night right before bed.

Stories were AMAZING so giving it two stars for that. However, The printers set the binding backward. You have to flip the book to what WOULD be the back cover, instead of using the front side, when you open the cover, in order to read it. I just didn't want to mess with returning... A bit disturbed about this simple error that ruined the book.
