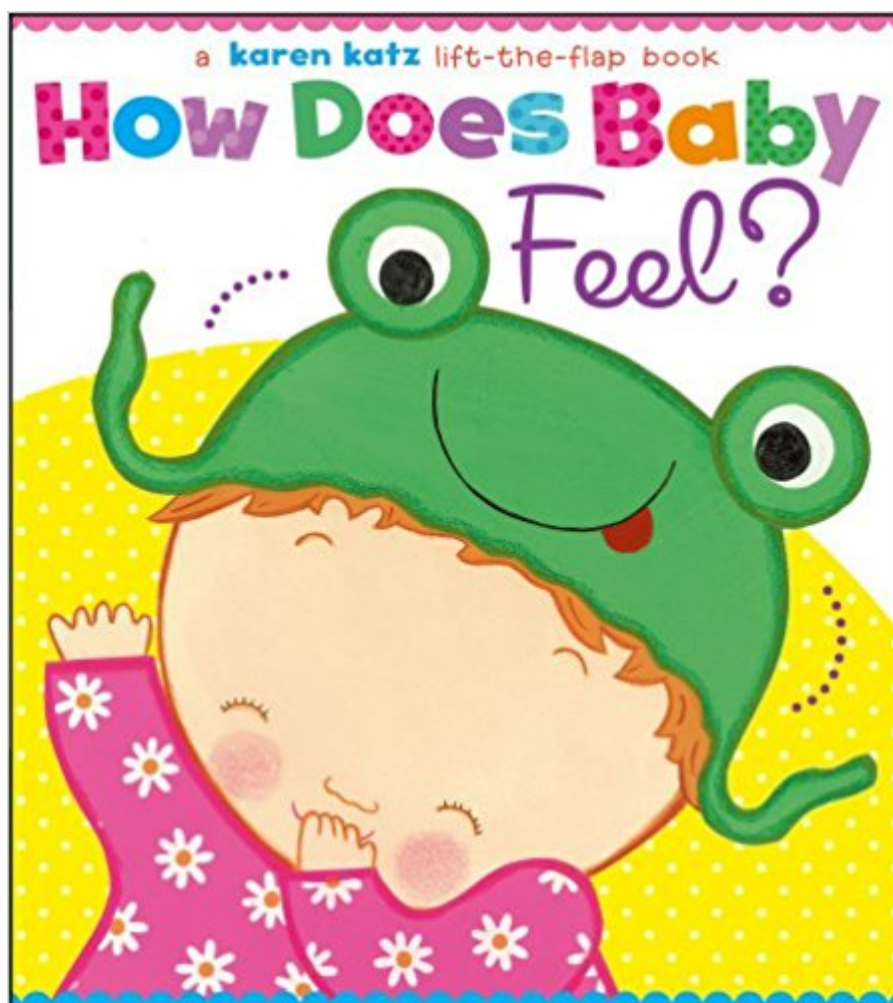

I bought this for my daughter because she loves flap books and really enjoyed *Where is Baby's Belly Button* by this same author. Unfortunately the flaps are the size of the whole page on every page and that makes it difficult for her to lift them so she loses interest. The illustrations and layout were cute anyway.

We wanted to get a book for our toddler to learn about feelings since she was feeling all the feels as a newly minted one year old toddler. :) Unfortunately, she expressed her frustration by tearing off the flaps! This book is good if you are supervising your kid, but we all know toddlers want to do things for themselves, and the flaps that go up are a little unexpected when most pages turn to the side in books. So the first read through had a lot of these flaps barely hanging on. :( Cute illustrations! But weak pages for a hulking toddler.

Our family enjoys all of the Karen Katz books. This would be a great book for a child just learning the concepts of happy/sad/angry/silly, etc. It simply illustrates single-word emotions. There is no narrative. I bought this book online (not knowing the specific contents) after my toddler already knew the handful of emotion/concepts described, so as a learning tool, it had more limited use than expected. But it is good reinforcement for what he knows, and we still enjoy reading it together and my toddler likes to flip the pages now and then. I would recommend this for a toddler/baby just learning emotions for the first time. After a toddler is already aware of labels for basic emotions, a narrative book on emotions would be a better fit.

I have a great book for my son called *Dear Zoo* that is a lift the flap book. It's his absolute favorite and so I was looking for something similar. In this book, the flaps are the size of the entire page which makes them hard for little fingers to pick at. It's the equivalent of trying to turn a page from the bottom which is tough for fine motor skills. The story however is very cute and I've enjoyed reading it with him.
