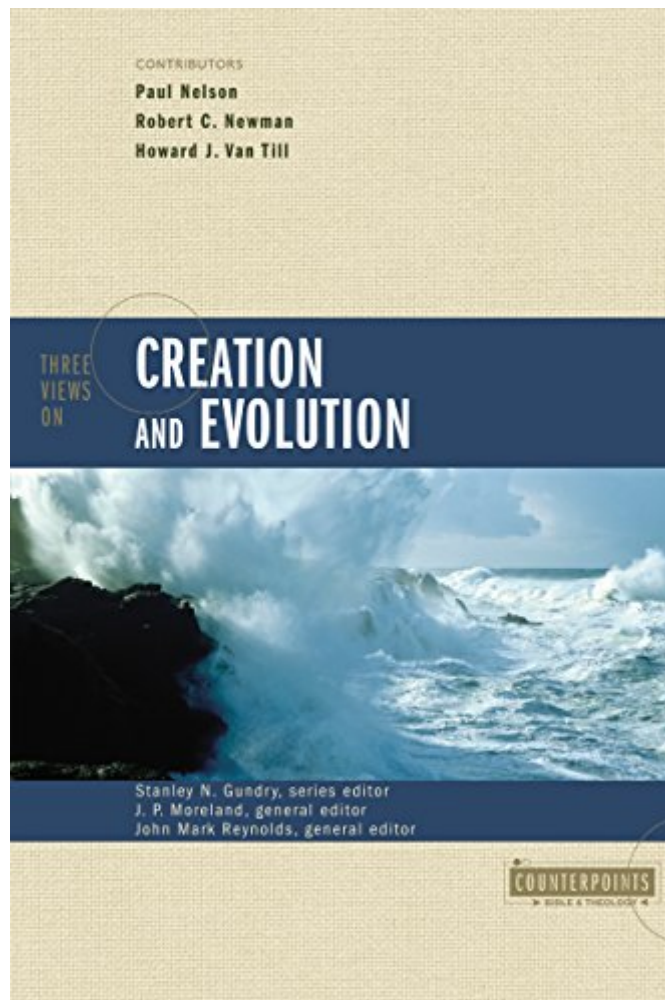

This is an extremely well-written introduction to the three primary views of creation held by Christians--old earth creationism, young earth creationism, and theistic evolution. A proponent of each of these views writes a summary of their position and the evidence that supports it, and then the other writers give responses. The conversation is very educational--even though I was acquainted with this three views before reading the book--I learned a great deal. The conversation by all participants was mutually respectful. Two responses complete the book, one by Richard Bube and another by Philip Johnson.
