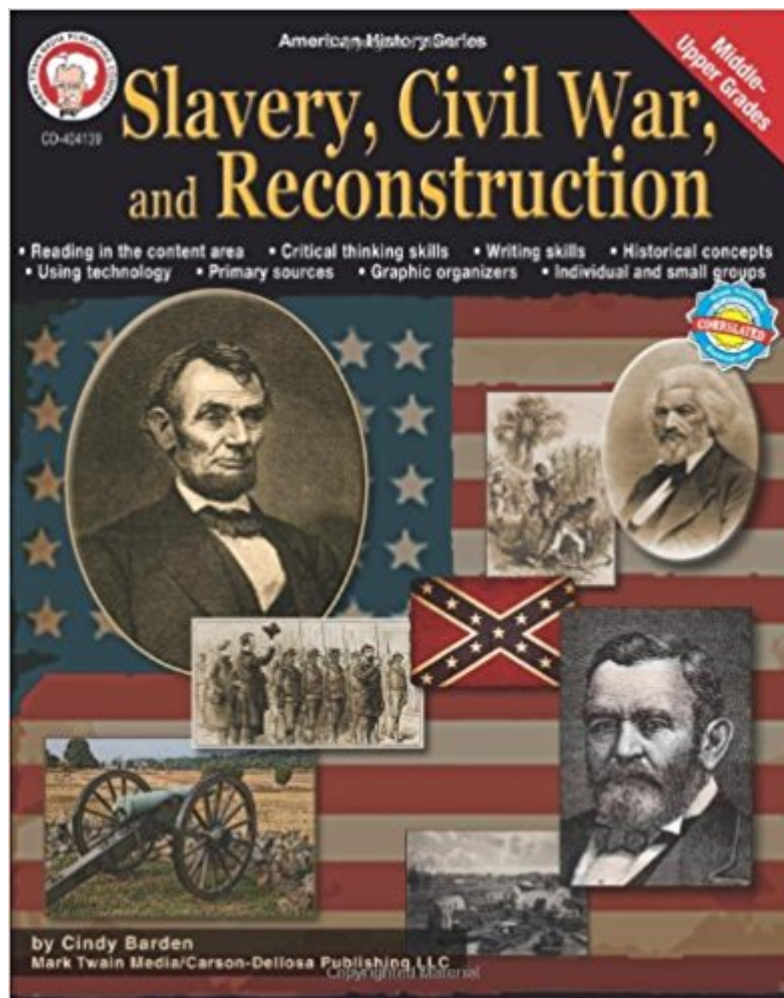




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Slavery, Civil War, And Reconstruction, Grades 6 - 12 (American History Series)
