Took this in my small cross-body every day on my Hong Kong trip. Was indispensable! So much insight - I got the previous version (I think there is a new version coming out this November), but they have a website and an app with some updated info. For Hong Kong, much was the same and not outdated.

The print is extremely small and difficult to read. The information was not as helpful as I had hoped. I really wanted art, architecture, museums, and history and the LUXE guide was not really better than other sources of information. I disliked the snotty tone of the writing. Possibly good for shopping and restaurants, a few, but extremely difficult to use since one would need maps as well.

These books are a travesty! I bought three Shanghai, Beijing, and Hong Kong) and wish I'd cancelled when there was such a delay. They aren't even books, but rather pamphlets with print so small, I can barely read it. They are so not the "Born to Shop" books. The only saving grace is the relatively minimal cost; but even then, Don't waste your money.
