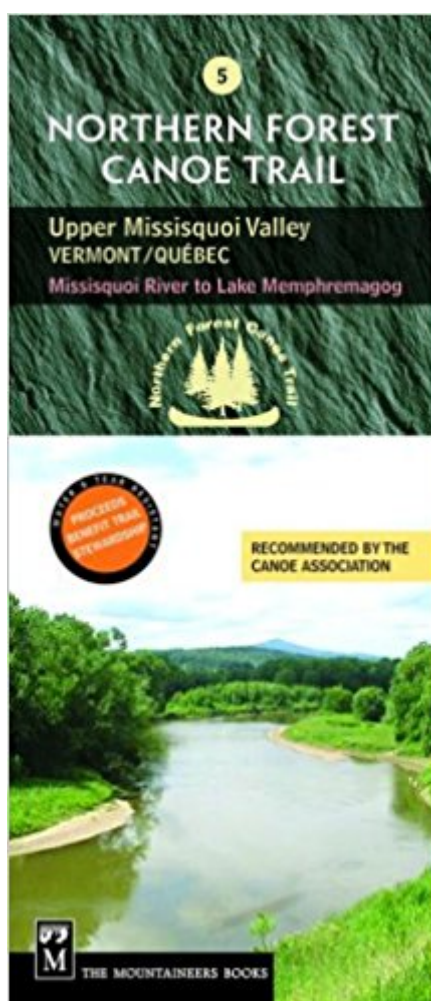


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Upper Missisquoi Valley, Vermont/Quebec: Missisquoi River To Lake Memphremagog (Northern Forest Canoe Trail Maps)
