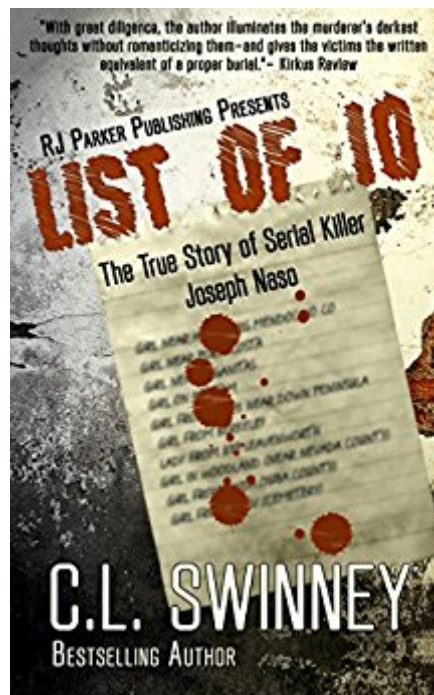

A very in-depth look into the crimes of Joseph Naso. Although the book is also about the killer himself, the author takes great care in making sure this is not just whom the book is about. It is about a list of women that Joseph had killed. Joe was very calculating in stalking his prey, sometimes taking weeks to know the victim before pouncing and tearing many lives apart. This book kept me interested and is one of Mr. Swinney's best works to date. I highly recommend reading this.

Joe Naso should be the last name on his list of ten. A person like this should have been put down long ago. C.L.Swinney does a great job of covering the crimes while giving meaning to the victims

without memorializing Naso. Swinney went to great lengths to interview the people involved in the case and even has notes from Naso himself, giving the reader insights to the workings of a crazed mind.

Joseph Naso, serial killer murdered 6 women. He would attract prostitutes by offering to take pictures of them in lingerie. Had it not been for petty thefts, Naso might have never been found out. He logged his sex attacks in a "rape diary". He was also associated with the Alphabet killings (the victims had the same letter in their first and last names) another great book from Chris Swinney.

This book was very well written coming from different perspectives of witnesses, victims, officers, and the suspect. The author really went out of his way to make this a complete and precise book. I could not put the book down after I started reading it. I hope CL Swinney keeps continuing on writing great books like this.

This book reads, as it was written, as if it were a very detailed perp report. It was written in a style that is used by law enforcement officers of which the writer is in that category. It would have been complimentary if more research were done to include his back story. It was a good read!
