I started reading the first book in this series, *Vengeance be Mine*, as part of the *Name Your Demon* book set, and was interested enough to purchase the second book in the series. Unfortunately I was disappointed to find out that this is actually a Novella, although the cover lists it as "Book 2". I believe I read this in a record 30 minutes, and was left wondering if there would be a series after all.
