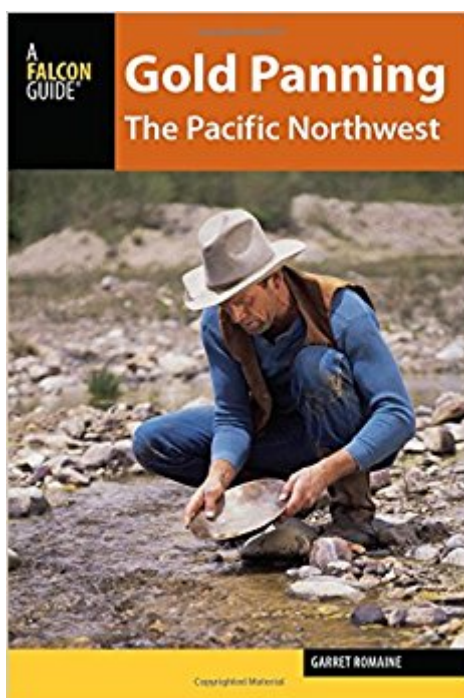


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Gold Panning The Pacific Northwest: A Guide To The Areaâ€™s Best Sites For Gold

Any book you buy will never have all the claims listed and new ones and old ones are always changing. It did miss some of the areas that our Gold prospecting club uses and some areas that are open for public use. But it did show some areas that I hadn't seen before.
