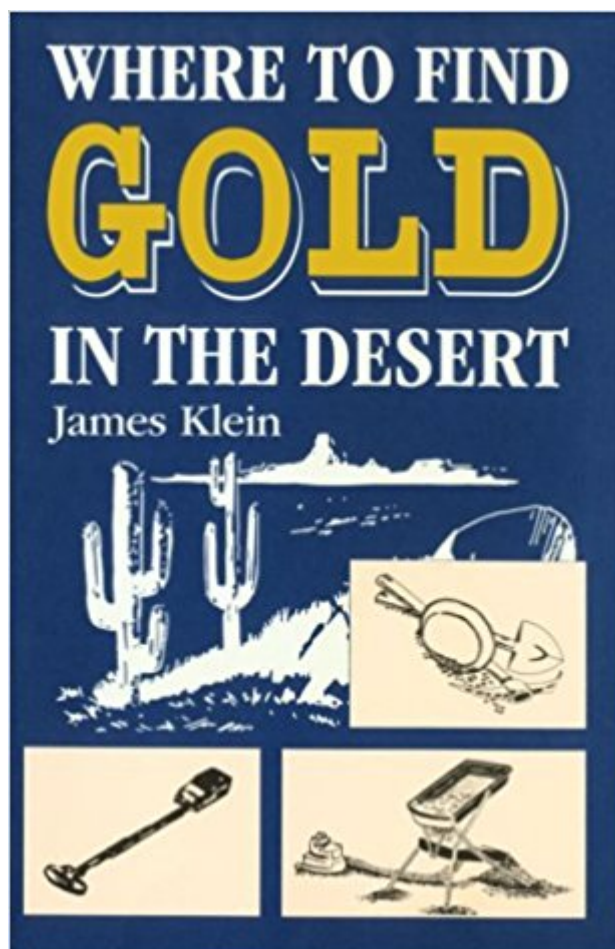

I rated this book five stars because it is the best book I've read on the subject - but it could have been a lot better. When I first bought the book I wanted something that would explain how to prospect for gold in the American Southwest... this book did just that, but only briefly. I've read "Finding Gold in the Desert (Prospecting and Treasure Hunting)" which only had a few pages on the subject; "Recreational Gold Prospecting for Fun & Profit" which wasn't specific to the desert; and others which only had maps and locations. All in all, this book could have been longer and more detailed. But until a better book comes along - this one remains unmatched. Although, the

book is a hefty 130 pages, the first 104 are dedicated to different gold sites in the Southwest - leaving only 26 for desert prospecting practices. These pages include geology, tips and tricks, drywashing, metal detecting, panning, and how to stake a claim - just don't expect too much information on each subject (sometimes only a page or two). For more specific information on prospecting in general I recommend "Recreational Gold Prospecting for Fun & Profit" as a companion.

This was a gift for my husband. Ordering and arrival were great. The book is good, but my husband was a little disappointed because it doesn't contain much information on Arizona or Nevada deserts; it focuses on California.

In the Nevada Desert there is Gold here and you don't have to go far, the Book basically talks about California, and other states besides Northern Nevada, but in general its a basic guideline for DESERTS in General and in this State you don't have to go far to find it, a metal detector, a little bit of dry panning and a whole lot of patience, and Dab nabit you can get Lucky too, happy Huntin.

The author tells stories of the location where gold was discovered in California. There are no area descriptions that could contain gold in the desert. The book tells lots of stories of old gold mines. Not my kind of book
