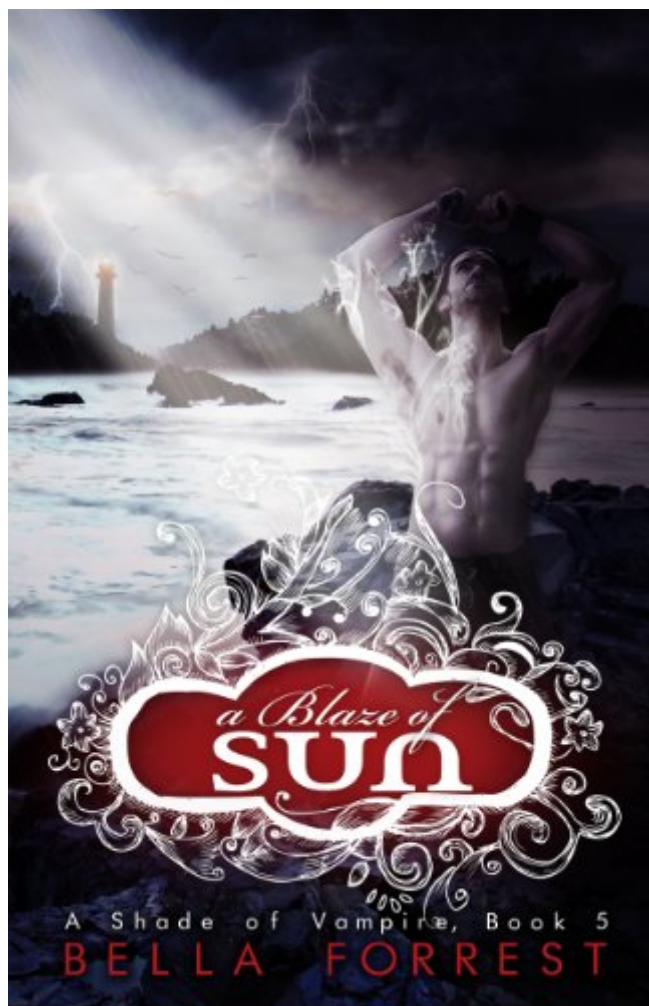

It really feels like all of the tidbits from the past 4 books really started to come together in this one!
