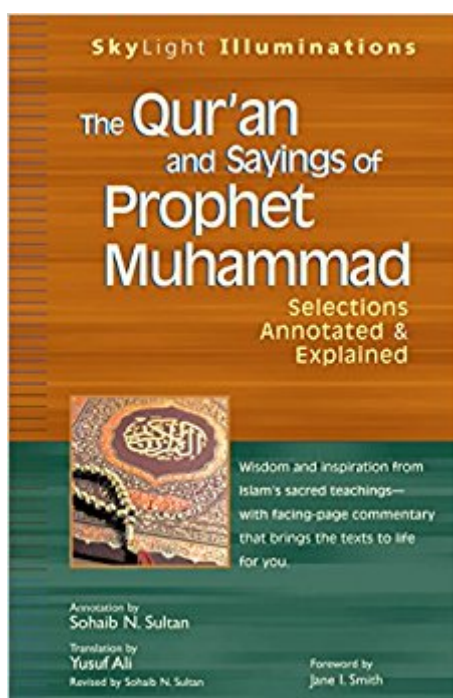


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The Qur'an And Sayings Of Prophet Muhammad: Selections Annotated & Explained (SkyLight Illuminations)
