As with HTML for Babies and CSS for Babies, there are no pictures to keep a baby's interest, and the only fun thing about the book is the multiple colors used on the various elements and parameters.

Nonsense

It is more for the parent (developers) to take pictures than the baby...

I've bought pretty much all of the nerdy books for babies, and while they all range quite a bit in quality, they all at least try to present some information in a fun manner. This series (HTML for Babies (Code Babies)/CSS for Babies (Code Babies)/Javascript for Babies (Code Babies)) does not try at all. They put two or three lines of poorly written code across two pages, so the whole book is maybe twenty lines of code. There's no explanation, story, pictures, or rhyme. They don't even bother to show what the output would be, probably because most of the output would likely just be an error message. For the record, the C++ for Kids (Code Babies) book from the same publisher is actually pretty awesome.

I expected this book to be a read-aloud story, or very very light info on JavaScript. It's actually a message written IN JavaScript. That makes it illegible for those who aren't fluent in it. Even if the message is read aloud, it's choppy. I try every once in a while to engage my 20-month-old with it, but she's not interested so far.
