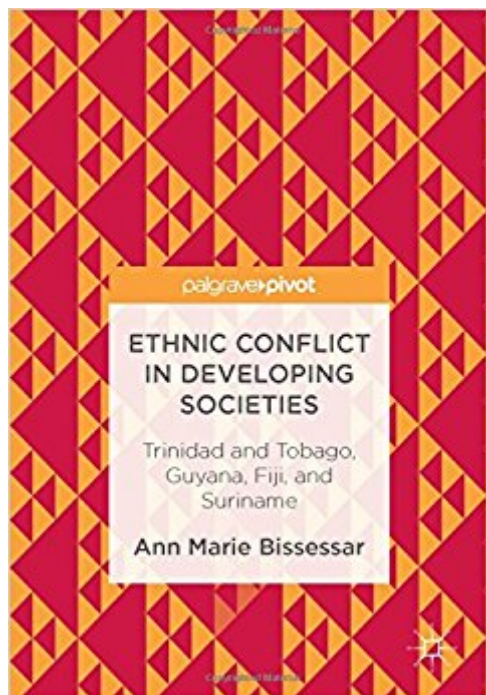




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# Ethnic Conflict In Developing Societies: Trinidad And Tobago, Guyana, Fiji, And Suriname
