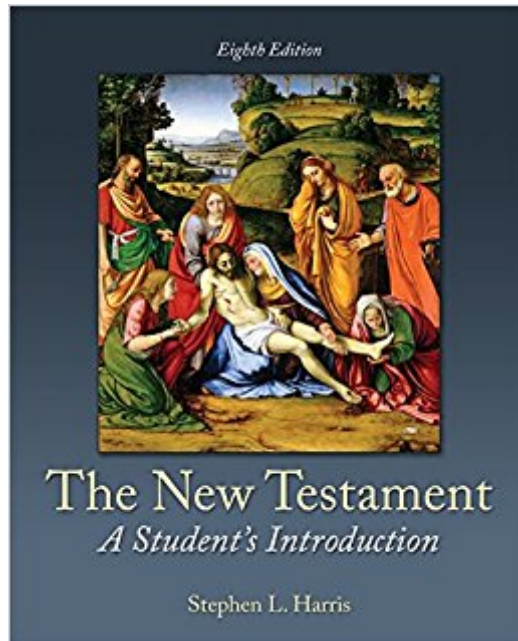

University, Sacramento, where he served ten years as department chair. A Woodrow Wilson Fellow, he received his M.A. and Ph.D. from Cornell University. A member of the Society of Biblical Literature, his publications include *Understanding the Bible* (8th edition, 2011); *The Old Testament: An Introduction to the Hebrew Bible* (with Robert Platzner); *Classical Mythology: Images and Insights* (with Gloria Platzner); *Exploring the Bible*; and *Fire Mountains of the West: The Cascade and Mono Lake Volcanoes*, a survey of volcanic hazards on the U.S. Pacific Coast; and for National Geographic Books, *Restless Earth*, a study of global earthquakes, tsunamis, and volcanic eruptions. He contributed the chapter on "Archaeology and Volcanism" to the *Encyclopedia of Volcanoes* (Academic Press, 2000).
